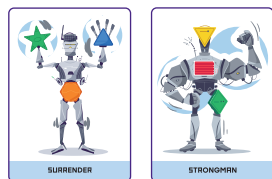


ROBODANCE

GAME RULES

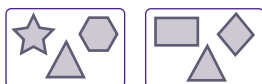
CONTENTS

- 20 robocards



Each robot has its own move, a set of 3 shapes, and 3 colors.

- 20 small cards with shapes



- 20 small cards with colors



- rules of the game

THE GOAL OF THE PLAYER

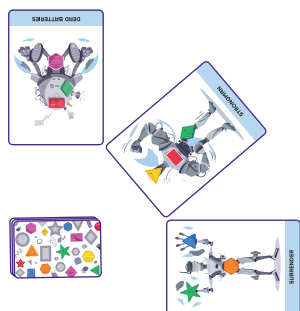
To score the most cards.

PREPARING FOR THE GAME

Put all small cards (with shapes and colors) in one stack and place it in the center of the table facing down.

Place 20 Robocards on the table facing up. Laying them out in a circle makes it easier for all players to see the cards.



The game consists of rounds.

Each round a different player becomes the game leader.

The leader's objective is to watch the players and determine the winner of the round.

GAME PROCESS

1. The leader draws a small card from the top of the stack, so that all players can see it at the same time.

2. Then **all players** start looking for a Robot that matches the card:

• If a color card was drawn, find a Robot with those exact 3 colors.



• If a shape card was drawn, you need a robot that has those exact 3 shapes.



There is **only one** right Robomatch. As soon as someone finds the right Robot he or she has **to repeat its move**.

3. The leader of the game pays attention to who was the first to repeat the right move. That person receives the small card and places it in their winning pile. The Robot is left on the table.

4. The role of the leader is passed on to the next player and the new round begins.

*There is **one special Robot** in the deck. If a small card matches a robot whose “batteries are dead”, **hug** the person who was the first one to repeat the robot’s move. Once the robot is “charged” the game continues.



THE END OF THE GAME

The game ends once the last small card has been played. The person who scored the most cards wins.

SIMPLIFIED VERSION

Remove the cards with shapes and leave only the cards with colors. This will significantly simplify the search for robots.
